Start/Finish

- 9:30 a.m. - Register and line-up in parking lot behind clock tower (E. Broad St.) Free Registration.
- 10 a.m. - Parade starts on sidewalk on the southern side of Broad St., travels west to Kelly St. and returns on sidewalk on the northern side of Broad St. Statesville Police will control traffic.



Rules

- No motorized entries; only self-propelled means of transportation allowed (bikes, trikes, wagons, strollers, your own feet)
- Kids riding bikes must wear helmets.
- Adults must accompany children.
- No pets allowed along the parade route.
